



STATEMENT of ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The Directors shall ensure that adequate resources are assigned to the pursuit and implementation of this Environmental Policy which has been developed to provide a strategic business tool to support our drive to become a market leader in the Hire of Plant and ancillary equipment (with or without operator) for municipal, traffic, construction and rail applications. The Assurance and Compliance Manager has been appointed as the environmental representative and has overall responsibility to ensure this Policy is implemented.

This Policy is communicated to all employees by suitable means which may include any induction training, display on notice boards, publication on our intranet and supply of copies to employees and sub-contractors and shall be made available to the public by suitable means including publication on our company website.
